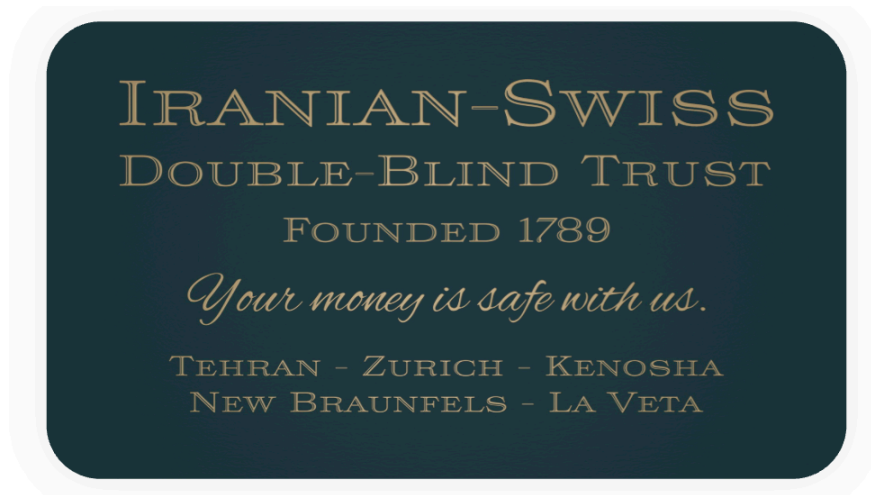

“It's not just in medical science that the phrase is used; it has massive utility right across our society. Take a look through Google for [exact hits on the phrase](#) and you'll find a fascinating portfolio of its use-cases. It's a functioning and highly utilised Jedi mind trick: state the magic words confidently enough and you'll leave well-meaning people with the opinion that there really is no evidence of [insert challenging idea here].”

“A few months ago I tried to address the “No evidence of X” problem by personally [translating some of that apparently non-existent evidence](#) into a format that a wider audience could engage with. It worked. Data that would ordinarily remain in a niche medical journal, in incredibly difficult prose, found a new audience of interested laypeople. “Evidence of X” had emerged from the shadows! It inspired an idea: what if I could use AI to do this at scale? Maybe then we could move the dial?

Zenodo now hosts a paper discussing results of autopsies after deaths suspected to be caused by experimental gene therapies (mRNA injections wrongly called vaccines). The paper was first published on a Lancet preprint server, and was then removed.

“Findings: The most implicated organ system in COVID-19 vaccine-associated death was the cardiovascular system (53%), followed by the hematological system (17%), the respiratory system (8%), and multiple organ systems (7%). Three or more organ systems were affected in 21 cases. The mean time from vaccination to death was 14.3 days. Most deaths occurred within a week from last vaccine administration. A total of 240 deaths (73.9%) were independently adjudicated as directly due to or significantly contributed to by COVID-19 vaccination.”

Dr. Paul Marik's history in medicine

He was trained in Critical Care, Neurocritical Care, Pharmacology, Internal Medicine, Anesthesia, Nutrition, and Tropical Medicine and Hygiene, and was a tenured Professor of Medicine and Chief of the Division of Pulmonary and Critical Care Medicine at Eastern Virginia Medical School (EVMS) in Norfolk, Virginia.

He has published over 500 peer-reviewed journal articles, written eighty book chapters, authored four critical care books, and has been cited over 43,000 times in peer-reviewed publications.

In medicine, scientists are given a ranking of their impact to their field by way of something called the h-index; Paul has an h-index of 110. For reference, a typical h-index for a professor ranges from 12 to 24, and most Nobel Prize winners score 30 or above.

Further, he has delivered over 350 lectures at international conferences and visiting professorships and won numerous awards, including the National Teacher of the Year award by the American College of Physicians in 2017.
